 and exhibit into the Lord Bishops' court at Lincoln' a
 true and perfect inventory, and thereof render and make a faithful
 and true account as shall be required by the ordinance of the
 diocese of Lincoln' for the time being called in and required: And she shall
 and heron' heirs or assigns of money as by the said ordinance be
 first paid and allowed by the said ordinary shall remaine in her said doo
 well and truly pay and distribute to and amongst such persons and persons
 in such manner and forme and at such time and place as the ordinance
 of the diocese aforesaid for the time being in this behalf assigne
 appoint: And lastly she shall save harmless the above named Lord Bishop of
 Lincoln' and all his officers and ministers against all persons for all charges
 and expences the granting of the said writs of administration of the said
 deceased's goods and chattels to her the said Mabel Lorde: And this
 party obligation to be void or else to remaine in full force and virtue //
