 the 17th year of the reigns of our Sovereigns Lord Charles
 the first King of England and in the year of our Lord God
 1664. I Thomas Lord of Wharfedale in the County of Lincoln
 husbandman beinge sick in his bed but of perfect remembrance
 thankes be to almighty god have made and ordeined this my last
 Will and Testament, authorly revokinge all other and former
 wills, doo make this my last Will and Testament in manner and
 followinge viz

First I bequeate my soule into the hande of almighty god my
 maker and reddeemer hopinge that through the Merits of Iesus
 Christ my onely Saviour and reddeemer, I maye receive good warden of
 almygnty god and for my body to be buried in Christian buriall
 at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter Mentioned And for
 my Temporall Estate I bequeate as followeth

First I give and bequeate unto my Sonne Thomas Lord
 Twentie pounde to be paynt out to him by my Wite in two year after
 my decease to be paynt into the hande of my trustie and well beloved
 frend Antony Johnson also I give to my said Sonne Thomas one
 longe table which standeth in the hall six buffett stools one great
 in the parlour which was his Mothers my will is that my wife shall
 have the use of the table the stools & the buffett until my Sonne shall
 attaine the age of one Twentie year if shee shall happen to
 live so long

Item I give to my two Daughters Elizabeth and Susan
 Twentie pounde apiece to be paid when they shall attaine
 their Souldal ages of one and Twentie year. And also my
 will is that if either of them shall happen to depart this life
 before they shall attaine the age of one Twentie year then
 my will is that they shall be one an other Executors and
 also my will is that if both of them shall happen to die be
 fore they come to their Souldal ages then my will is that the
 said Twentie pounde apiece before bequeated shal be to my Daughters
 shall be made in the hande of my Executors.

Also my will is that if my Sonne Thomas shall happen to
 depart this life before he attaine the age of one Twentie
 year then my will is that the Money before bequeated be
 paid in to the hande of my Executors.

Item I give to Anne Gardner my Wifes Daughter ten pounde
 to be paid by my Executors when shee shall attaine the age of
 one Twentie year

Item I give to my Brother John Lord Twentie Shillinge
 to be paid by my Executors with in six month after my decease
 And his acquittance to be my Executors Discharge

Item I give to Daniell Browne five shillings
to be paid by my Executors

All the rest of my goods and Chattels Unbequeathed
I give unto Anne my wife whom I do make my full
and sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament
Shee pay my Debts and Charges and bringing
my Body decently to the ground And I request my heires
and well beloved friends Anthony Johnson to be Supervisor
of this my last will and Testament in witness whereof
I have set to my hand and Seal first above written

This words to the best of his knowledge
the age of one & twenty years was
declared before the sealing & hereof
