1664. I Thomas Lord of Wharfedale in the County of Lincoln
husbandman beinge sick in bed but of perfect remembrance
thankes be to almighty god have Maide and ordeined this my last
Will and Testament, authorly revokinge all other and former
wills doe Make this my last will and Testament in Manner and
followinge viz

First I bequeate my soule into the hands of almighty god my
maier and redemption hopinge that through the Merits of Iesus
Christ my onely Saviour and redemptor I maye receive good reward of
almyg Sins And as for my Body to be buried in Christian buriall
at the discretion of my Executors hereafter Mentioned And for
my Temporall Estate I bequeate as followeth:

I give and bequeate unto my Son Thomas Lord of
Twentie poundes to be paynt cut to 100th part with in two years after
my decess to be put into the hands of my trustie and welbelovyd
friends Antony Johnson also I give to my said Son Thomas one
longe tabell which standeth in the hall six bussett stools one great
in the parlour which was his Mothers My will is that my wife shall
have the use of the Tabell the stools &c the best until my sons shall
attaine the age of one Twentie years if shes shall happen to
live so long

I then I give to my two Daughters Elizabeth and Susan
Twentie poundes apiece to be paid when they shall attaine
their Souldall ages of one and Twentie years And also my
will is that if either of them shall happen to depart this life
before they shall attaine the age of one Twentie years then
my will is that they shall be one an other Executors and
also my will is that if both of them shall happen to die be
fore they come to their Souldall ages then my will is that the
said Twentie poundes apiece before bequeated to my Daughters
shall be made in the hands of my Executors.

Also my will is that if my son Thomas shall happen to
depart this life before he attaine the age of one Twentie
years then my will is that the Money before bequeated be
paid in to the hands of my Executors.

I then I give to Anne Gardner my wife Daughters 100th poundes
to be paid by my Executors when shes shall attaine the age of
one Twentie years

I then I give to my Brother John Lord Twentie Shillinges
to be paid by my Executors with in six monthes after my decess
And his acquittance to be my Executors discharge

Item I give to Daniell Browne five shillings
to be paid by my Executors

All the rest of my goods and Chattels Unbequeathed
I give unto Anne my wife whom I do make my full
and sole Executor of this my last will and Testament
Shee pay my Debt and Charge and burying of
my Body decently to the ground And I request my friends
and well beloved friends Anthony Johnson to be Supervisor
of this my last will and Testament in witness whereof
I have set to my hand and Seal this above written
